Use a suitable design

strategies → LETTER

Lead → Intro

Report Etc.

Rewrite:  
a. Objective consideration of contemporary phenomena compels  
the conclusion that success or failure in competitive contests  
no tendency to be commensurate with innate capacity, but that  
a considerable element of the unpredictable must inevitably be  
taken into account.  
"If one is to write, one must believe in the ability of  
the reader to receive and decode the message"

"Writing is an act of faith, not a trick of grammar"

→ involves groups of words (like  
Reading) → Concepts, more  
than any specific word. Rd  
personal journey (a process) in the direction  
of plainness, simplicity, orderliness, sincerity

STYLE

A - Write, Revise, Rewrite → R. Hem / L. Hem. ⇒  
use nouns + verbs Be careful with

C Prefer "standard" & offbeat spelling - don't make


