Supporting Christian Scientists
in Eastern Ontario

Who we are:

The Concord Lodge Association of Ottawa was established in 1967 and endeavors to ensure that anyone who needs Christian Science nursing or practitioner care will receive it when costs may be prohibitive to the individual. We also provide housing assistance to Christian Scientists in the eastern Ontario region. The Association is a registered charity and operates with a membership and an elected board of volunteer directors. The Board meets monthly to manage the affairs of the Association.

What we do:

The Association seeks to help Christian Scientists maintain their independence by supporting their housing and personal care needs. At this time the Association considers it most prudent to assist Christian Scientists in their own homes but may also assist financially with a short term stay at a Christian Science facility. To this end the Association provides financial assistance when needed for nursing and practitioner care. We also support a housing assistance program that aims to help Christian Scientists find appropriate solutions for their individual needs.


Visiting Nurse Service

While relying on prayer for healing sometimes there is a practical need. A Christian Science nurse can assist with such practical needs whilst fully supporting the healing environment with clarity of thought and encouragement. The nurse is available seven days a week and can skillfully assist with tasks such as:

- Bandaging, wound and injury care
- Regular bathing
- Preparation of meals and feeding
- Providing advice on mobility aids

The nurse works independently and patients are invoiced directly for nursing services. Benevolence is provided anonymously by the Association for those in need. Verification of financial need may be requested for extended assistance. Each case will be reviewed on a monthly basis. All contact with the nurse is completely confidential.

Housing Assistance

The Concord Lodge Association works together with the Friendship Committee of the First Church of Christ Scientist, Ottawa to address housing needs in the Christian Science community. At this time the Association seeks to enable Christian Scientists to remain comfortably in their own private accommodation by finding unique solutions for each individual's need.

The nurse is able to advise on all aspects of care for those relying on Christian Science for healing. The nurse can provide information on community services available in the Ottawa area to assist with household tasks such as meal preparation and cleaning.

If a move to more appropriate accommodation is required the Association can provide contacts for professional financial and real estate services, and if necessary, a volunteer to help individuals investigate accommodation options. Manual assistance with moving can also be arranged.

The Association currently has funds available to help Christian Scientists with their housing needs and is happy to have you apply if you need temporary assistance. To prevent anyone from becoming financially dependent on the Association the Board prefers to provide one time payments for specific items rather than ongoing subsidies. The Board is open to creative solutions for your housing needs.
