Dr. Isaac Sobol of Igaluit writes about Peter Morrin, whose obituary appeared Nov. 2.

In 1985, I was a medical student at Queen's University, where I was assigned to a clinical training rotation with Peter Morrin. I had no idea of his background as a pioneer in kidney dialysis, or of his prior work in the U.S.

I do recall the good humour, compassion and assistance he demonstrated while I worked with him in the renal unit of Kingston General Hospital. At that time, some of the Queen's medical faculty exhibited an almost adversarial approach to medical students, yet Dr. Morrin's supportive and collegial behaviour has always remained in my memory as a true, positive role model.
