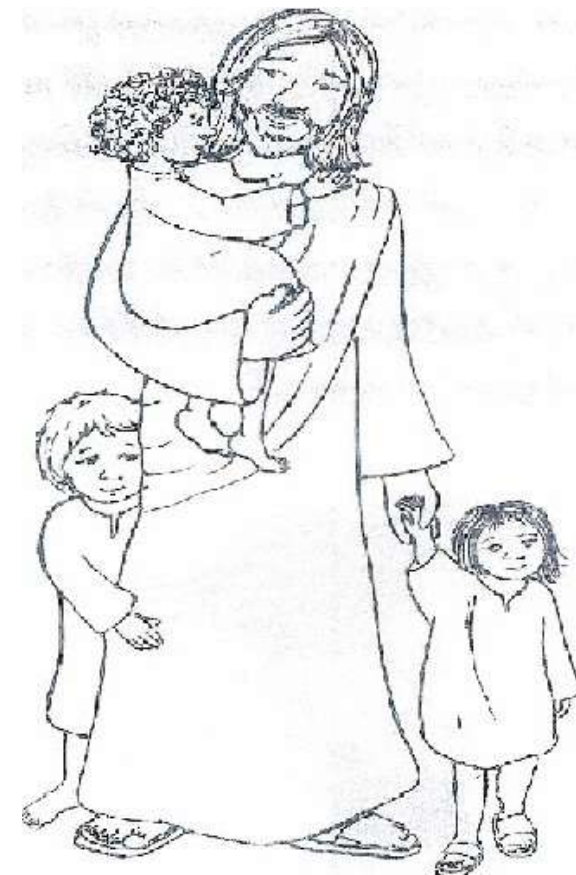

Sunday Morning

Children start their morning worship in the congregation where a "children's story" based on that Sunday's scripture is told. Following this the children leave for Church School and their own special classes. The children rejoin the congregation at the peace to celebrate the Eucharist.

All our church school programs are taught by caring volunteers who are screened for this ministry.

Children age 0 - 3 are welcome to our recently renovated nursery which is monitored by screened volunteers.

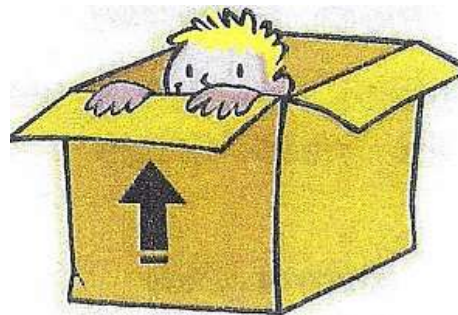
Our classes are divided into 4 main groups:
